The purpose of the Climate Action and Resiliency Ad Hoc is to develop a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors regarding a future structure for Board Member engagement in climate action and resiliency issues in 2023. The Ad Hoc will also make recommendations regarding the proposed range of climate action and resiliency topics that would potentially be addressed during 2023 under the structure recommended by the Ad Hoc, as well as recommendations regarding public engagement and staff reporting on the County's climate action and resiliency work. Recommendations will be presented to the Board of Supervisors in December of 2022.
