

ORDINANCE NO. ()

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2300 TO MODIFY EXISTING PASSENGER LOADING AND NO PARKING ZONE RESTRICTIONS ON BOWER STREET (#79027) AT OAK GROVE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, ordains as follows:

Section I.

- A. Subsection 390 is hereby deleted from Section VII of Sonoma County Ordinance No. 2300 (said Section establishes No Parking Zones).
- B. Subsection 391 is hereby deleted from Section VII of Sonoma County Ordinance No. 2300 (said Section establishes No Parking Zones).
- C. Subsection 571 is hereby added to Section VII of Sonoma County Ordinance No. 2300 (said Section establishes No Parking Zones) to read:

East side of Bower Street (#79027) beginning at a point 510 feet west of the center line of Oak Grove Avenue (#79021) and extending for a distance of 450 feet west and north (Postmile 10.10 to Postmile 10.185).

- D. Subsection 34 is hereby added to Section XI of Sonoma County Ordinance No. 2300 (said Section establishes Passenger Loading Zones) to read:

North side of Bower Street (#79027) for a distance of 490 feet west (Postmile 10.00 to Postmile 10.071) from the center line of Oak Grove Avenue (#79021) from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekdays.

Section II. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and every section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section III. This Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby declared to be in full force and effect from and after thirty (30) days after the date of its passage and shall be published once before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after said passage, with the names of the Supervisors voting for or against the same, in *The Press Democrat*, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sonoma, State of California.
