Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, authorizing the District Attorney to participate in the Unserved/Underserved

Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program

and to execute a contract with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services

for Calendar Year 2023 in the amount of \$196,906.

Whereas, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors and the Sonoma County District
Attorney desire to create a certain program designated as the Unserved/Underserved
Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program as a provider of direct culturally-appropriate
education and support services to immigrant communities in Sonoma County; and

**Whereas,** the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program is to be funded through a grant award made available through California Governor's Office of Emergency Services; and

**Whereas,** the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has allocated \$196,906 to the County of Sonoma for the 2023 Calendar Year.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the District Attorney or their designee for the County of Sonoma is authorized, on behalf of this body to accept a grant for Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program and is authorized to execute on behalf of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors the Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or modifications thereof.
