**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,  
Terminating The Existence of a Local Emergency Due To  
The Potential Introduction Of COVID-19 In The Sonoma County Operational Area**

**Whereas**, California Government Code section 8630 and Section 10.5 of the Sonoma County Code empower the County Administrator to proclaim the existence of a local emergency when Sonoma County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and

**Whereas**, on March 2, 2020, the Director of Emergency Management for the County of Sonoma issued a Proclamation of a Local Emergency related to the potential introduction of COVID-19 in the Sonoma County Operational Area; and

**Whereas**, on March 4, 2020, the Board of Supervisors ratified the Proclamation of a Local Emergency by the County of Sonoma's Director of Emergency Management and found that the circumstances of the potential introduction of COVID-19 in the Sonoma County Operational Area as described in the Director's Proclamation of Local Emergency did support and justify the declaration of local emergency as set forth therein; and

**Whereas**, the Board of Supervisors finds that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities within the Sonoma County Operational Area.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** the Board of Supervisors does hereby terminate the Proclamation of Local Emergency, effective immediately upon the adoption of this resolution.
