NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, at 8:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, on Tuesday, March 12, 2019, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers at 575 Administration Drive, Room 102A, Santa Rosa, California, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma ("County") will conduct a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, at which it will hear and consider information concerning a proposed plan of financing providing for the issuance by the California Public Finance Authority of revenue bond anticipation notes in one or more series issued from time to time, including bonds issued to refund such revenue bond anticipation notes in one or more series from time to time, and at no time to exceed \$14,000,000 in outstanding aggregate principal amount, to finance and refinance the acquisition, development and construction of an approximately 274-unit senior living facility project located at 16977 Healdsburg Avenue, Healdsburg, California. The facilities are to be owned by Kendal at Sonoma, a Zen Inspired Community, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, and are generally to be known as Enso Village (the "Project").

Those wishing to comment on the proposed financing and refinancing and the nature and location of the Project may either appear in person at the public hearing or submit written comments, which must be received no later than 4:00 pm on Monday, March 11, 2019, to the Clerk of the Board at bos@sonoma-county.org.
