Proclaiming March, 2019 as Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month in Sonoma County

Whereas, In 1987, President Ronald Reagan issued a public proclamation that the month of March would be recognized as Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month to "increase public awareness of the needs and potential of Americans with disabilities", also, rights for the more than five million Americans who have a developmental disability were furthered with the passage of the Americans with Disabilities Act in 1990; and
