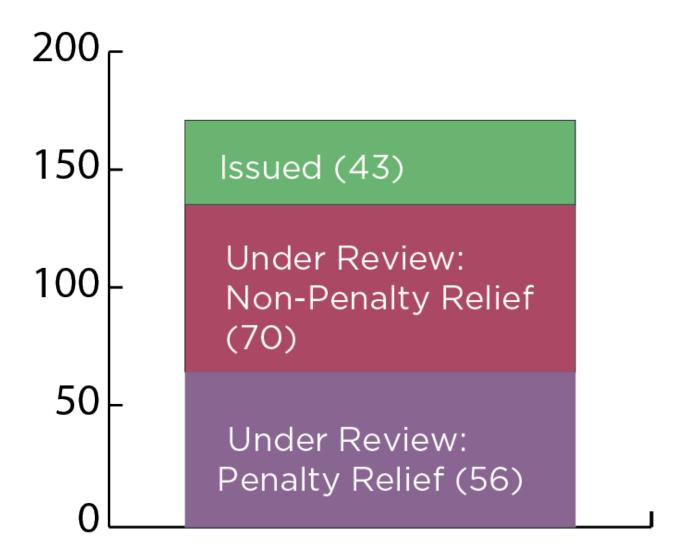

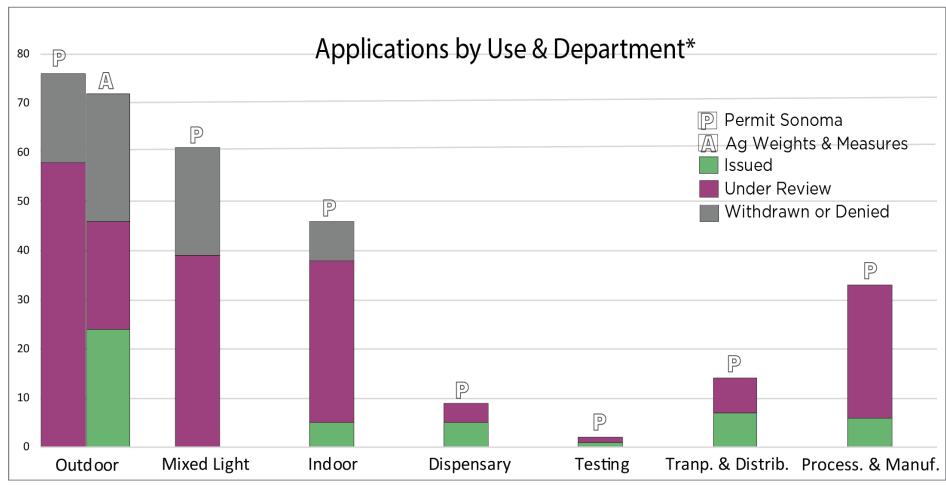
PERMITTING STATUS
