Authorize and direct the Executive Director of the Commission to execute Agreements with FY 2019-20 subrecipients and developers on behalf of the County in accordance with the Action Plan: One Year Use of Funds FY 2019-20, to execute amendments and modifications to said Agreements, to execute loan and grant documents with subrecipients and developers consistent with the terms set forth in the Commission's policies that govern use of I HOME Investment Partnership, Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Solutions Grants funds, and to execute construction contracts, and related agreements on behalf of program beneficiaries, in accordance with the applicable program designs.
- 7. Approve the recommended awards for the Community Services Fund as attached to this Summary Report for use of \$610,000 that is included in the Commission's recommended FY 2019-20 budget, and authorize the Executive Director of the Commission to execute Grant Agreements and related agreements for the use of said funds.
- 8. Approve the recommended awards for Low- and Moderate-Income Housing Asset Funds as attached to this Summary Report for use of \$250,000, and authorize the Executive Director of the Commission to execute Grant Agreements and related agreements for the use of said funds.
- 9. Approve the recommended awards for Sonoma Valley Homeless Initiatives Funding, funded by Transient Occupancy Tax as attached to this Summary Report for use of \$250,000, and authorize the Executive Director of the Commission to execute Grant Agreements and related agreements for the use of said funds.
