

**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE OF
SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
TO ESTABLISH THE FEES TO BE COLLECTED BY THE SHERIFF-
CORONER'S OFFICE**

On April 30th, 2019, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed ordinance to establish fees to be collected by the Sheriff-Coroner's Office, including an overall net fee revenue increase of \$3,788. Areas of change include a projected revenue decrease in the Central Information Bureau, a revenue decrease in the Coroner's Office, a revenue increase in the Patrol Bureau, and a revenue increase in the Telecommunications Unit. These proposed fee changes would take effect on July 1, 2019 and are necessary to recover the reasonable cost to provide these services.
