## Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, Adopting the Department of Agriculture/Weights and Measures' Fees for the Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) Hazardous Materials Program, Vineyard and Orchard Site Development and Agricultural Grading and Drainage (VESCO) Project Review, Cannabis Cultivation Program, and for Agriculture Division and Land Stewardship Section Staff Hourly Rates

Whereas, Sonoma County Code Chapter 29 authorizes the Board to adopt a schedule of fees and charges for services provided and permits issued pursuant to Chapter 29 of the Sonoma County Code to recover the reasonable cost of providing such services and issuing such permits; and

Whereas, Sonoma County Code Chapter 11 authorizes the Board of Supervisors by resolution to establish fees and hourly rates for providing various reviews, inspections, and services made, issued, and provided by the Department of Agriculture/Weights & Measures, and

Whereas, Government Code Section 6253.0, Sonoma County Code Chapter 26 and Chapter 36, and other provisions of the law authorize the Board of Supervisors by resolution to establish fees to recover the reasonable cost of providing for various inspections, reinspections, testing, certificates, registrations, and services made, issued and provided by the County Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures (hereinafter called "The Commissioner/Sealer")

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that to recover the reasonable cost of providing various reviews, inspections, and services made, issued, and provided by the Department of Agriculture/Weights & Measures, it is necessary to impose the fees and rates set forth below.
