Concurrent Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, The Board Of Directors Of The Sonoma County Water Agency, The Board Of Commissioners Of The Community Development Commission, And The Board Of Directors Of The Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation And Open Space District Adopting the County of Sonoma Continuity Of Operations Plan (COOP).

Whereas, Continuity of Operations Plans provide the ability for the County to maintain critical services in the event of utility or information systems disruption, labor resource conflict, major emergency, or disaster; and

Whereas, it is the County's objective to have a well prepared and trained workforce to quickly and efficiently respond to the community's needs in times of emergency and disaster; and

Whereas, training and exercise requirements, and necessary resources shall be identified to support and maintain an integrated and effective County Continuity of Operations program, and the concept of mandatory disaster service training including a minimum of 1% (20 hours) of full-time equivalent work hours per employee shall be evaluated and developed; and

Whereas, County departments and agencies have developed a comprehensive, integrated Continuity of Operations Base Plan and supporting Department/Division Playbooks.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma hereby takes the following action:

1. Adopts the County of Sonoma Continuity of Operations Plan as presented.
2. Delegates maintenance of the Continuity of Operations Plan to the County's Director of Emergency Management.
