- Background
 - Sonoma County DHS-BHD has implemented a set of Suicide Prevention Activities that are ongoing
 - Targeted and tailored approach needed to adequately impact suicides on the rail lines

Initial Recommendations and Resources (continued)

- Research & Evaluation Preventing Suicides on Rail Lines
 - Barriers Interrupting behavior results in long term resolution of suicidal impulse
 - Signage/Messaging Suicide prevention messages and resources can redirect at-risk individuals
 - Training Train relevant individuals (e.g., SMART staff) in identification of and response to at-risk individuals
 - Media Research-based guidelines for media reporting of deaths by suicide to reduce risk of suicide and avoid unintentionally increasing risk of suicide
