WHEREAS, as a young man of 16 years old, Gary chose to not follow his family on their move to Willits, and instead stayed in Sonoma County, worked hard at a variety of odd jobs and bought his own house, a mobile home at 18; and

WHEREAS, valuing and focusing on relationships all around the world, getting to know the owners and the cheesemakers, Gary put like-minded people together and grew Sage Marketing; and
