Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,

Whereas, unclaimed funds of an amount more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) are on deposit with the County Treasurer; and

Whereas, California Government Code Section 50055 provides that any amount if the depositor's name is unknown, which remains unclaimed in the treasury or in the official custody of an officer of a local agency for the period of one year may be transferred to the General Fund by the legislative body without the necessity of publication of a notice in a newspaper; and

Whereas, the depositor's name is known, California Government Code Section 50050 provides that money that is not the property of the County and remains unclaimed in its treasury or in the official custody of its officers for three years is the property of the County after notice has been published once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation and if no person has claimed the money or filed and served a verified complaint; and

Whereas, the Sheriff's Office caused notice to be published in the Press Democrat in satisfaction of the requirements of Government Code Section 50051; and

Whereas, no person has claimed the money or filed and served a verified complaint; and

Whereas, unclaimed funds in the amount of \$22,304.70 are now the property of the County and are currently deposited in trust with the Sheriff's Office; and

Whereas, California Government Code Section 50053 provides that when any such money becomes the property of the County and is in a special fund, the legislative body may transfer it to the General Fund.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that pursuant to the provisions of Section 50053, the unclaimed \$22,304.70 which has become the property of the County shall be transferred to the County's General Fund.
