Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Annual Inmate Welfare Trust Fund Report

The Annual Inmate Welfare Trust Fund Report serves to meet the requirement outlined in the California Penal Code, Section 4025 (e) which requires that an itemized report of trust fund revenues and expenditures be submitted annually to the Board of Supervisors.

The Jail Stores Trust Fund and the Inmate Welfare Trust Fund are two separate funds utilized in the inmate accounting system. The Jail Stores Trust Fund was established as the operating fund for the Inmate Commissary. The Inmate Welfare Trust Funds holds the money to be spent by the Sheriff primarily for the benefit, education, and welfare of inmates confined within the jail. Any funds that are not needed for the welfare of inmates may be spent for the maintenance of the county jail facilities or as otherwise deemed appropriate by the Sheriff, in accordance with the Penal Code.

Jail Stores Trust Fund

Revenues generated in this fund come from commissary sales, inmate vending sales, aluminum can recycling and prior year revenue. Expenditures are classified in the following categories: salaries and benefits, merchandise expenses, operating expenses, and operational transfers to the Inmate Welfare Trust. Profit generated from the operation of the commissary is a significant source of revenue for the Inmate Welfare Fund Trust. Exhibit "A" is a detailed summary of the Jail Stores Trust revenues and expenditures for FY 18-19.

Inmate Welfare Trust Fund

The Inmate Welfare Trust Fund is managed through the Inmate Welfare Trust Committee. The Sheriff or his designee has authority over all Inmate Welfare Trust Fund activities. Revenues received in this fund are derived from the following sources: interest generated from the fund balances of both trust funds, vending machine commissions, inmate telephone commissions, miscellaneous revenues, and transfer from the Jail Stores Trust Fund (profit from various sources). Exhibit "B" is detailed summary of the Inmate Welfare Trust revenues and expenditures for FY 18-19.
