**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,  
Recognizing Women’s Empowerment 2020 (WE-2020) Activities in Sonoma County  
Celebrating and Commemorating the Upcoming 2020 Centennial Anniversary of the  
Nineteenth Amendment, Women’s Constitutional Right To Vote**

**Whereas,** The Nineteenth Amendment became part of the United States Constitution on August 18, 1920 stating “The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex”; and

**Whereas,** In Sonoma County, Women’s Empowerment 2020 (WE-2020) is planning a year-long celebration to commemorate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of women’s right to vote, whose mission is to Elevate, Celebrate and Inspire Women Throughout Sonoma County; and

**Whereas,** WE-2020 goals are to increase the number of women who: vote, run for office, lead organizations and to connect women leaders with women and girls who are ready to move into leadership roles; and

**Whereas,** Sonoma County founded the Women’s History Project which petitioned Congress for the creation of National Women’s History Month, a nation-wide event occurring by Presidential proclamation in March of every year as a month set aside to honor women's contributions in American history, making the goal of Sonoma County’s WE-2020 to empower Sonoma County women to attain true equity especially appropriate; and

**Whereas**, WE-2020 plans to create and produce a limited number of high profile events, will have a strong presence at existing events, will design and maintain an interactive web hub to connect women and uncover those career fields where women remain in the minority, will raise funds to pay its contributors and secure speakers and performers not generally seen in Sonoma County and is deeply committed to increasing the number of women who vote and the number of girls who will pre-register to vote.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors recognizes the activities of Women’s Empowerment 2020 (WE-2020) in Sonoma County to celebrate and commemorate the upcoming 2020 Centennial Anniversary of the Nineteenth Amendment, Women’s Constitutional Right to Vote.
