**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California,
Introducing, Reading the Title, and Waiving Further Reading of a Proposed Ordinance
Imposing a ½-cent Transactions and Use Tax (Sales Tax) to Provide Additional Funding for
Sonoma County Wildfire Prevention, Emergency Alert and Response, and increasing the
County's Appropriation (Spending) Limit to Allow Expenditure of the Proceeds of the
Proposed Transactions and Use Tax**

Whereas, a proposed ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Of The County Of Sonoma Imposing A Transactions And Use Tax To Be Administered By The California Department Of Tax And Fee Administration For Protecting The Public With Improved Emergency Alerts, Vegetation Management And Wildfire Prevention And Increasing The Appropriations Limit For The County to allow expenditure of the proceeds of the proposed tax," imposing a countywide ½-cent countywide special Transaction and Use Tax (Sales Tax) until repealed by the voters of Sonoma County, has been introduced and the title read.
