Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County Of Sonoma, State of California, authorizing budget adjustments for FY19-20 in the amount of \$175,073 for the District Attorney's Office to reflect the elimination of 3.0 full-time equivalent Victim Claims positions effective by December 31st, 2019

Whereas, state agency referred to as the California Victim Compensation Board (CalVCB) is cancelling a contract for services with the Sonoma County District Attorney's office to provide the state assistance in processing victims' claims for qualifying expenses

Whereas, the contract cancellation results in a reduction of \$174,520 in state revenue and a projected \$554 reduction in needed general funds

Whereas, the contract cancellation results in a reduction of \$175,074 in projected salary and benefit costs

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors have adopted a Final Budget for the County of Sonoma for FY19-20:

Whereas, the Government Code allows for adjustments to the Final Budget.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors declares the County's Auditor-Controller is hereby authorized and directed to amend the District Attorney's Office's FY19-20 budget as follows:
