Joe Rodota Trail Indoor-Outdoor Shelter Site Selection Criteria

The Sonoma County Department of Health Services and the Sonoma County Community Development Commission shall apply the following criteria in the identification of a site to act as an indoor-outdoor shelter:

- a) **Accessibility**. The site allows occupants to easily walk and is accessible to individuals with mobility limitations.
- b) **Site Characteristics**. The site size, configuration, entrance access, perimeter security, parking, potential environmental hazards, and occupancy date.
- c) **Close to Transportation**. Within a quarter mile of transportation services.
- d) **Proximity to Services**. Within a quarter mile of neighborhood serving retail, health facilities, etc.
- e) Utilities. Available utilities including water, sewer, and electrical connections.
- f) **Cost**. Lease costs, capital improvements, projected ongoing maintenance costs, operating costs.

Health Services and CDC will work closely with General Services, County Counsel and other Departments and community stakeholders as required to identify an appropriate site(s) for the indoor-outdoor shelter.
