in 1979, the historic Santa Rosa Post Office and Federal Building was moved to its current location on Seventh Street, renovated as a museum space, and placed on the National Register of Historic Places; and,

WHEREAS, the Museum of Sonoma County opened its doors on January 12, 1985 and is celebrating its 35th anniversary; and,

WHEREAS, following a series of expansions, the Museum of Sonoma County's campus now stretches the entire Seventh Street block between A and B Streets in Downtown Santa Rosa; and,

WHEREAS, the Museum of Sonoma County's mission is to engage and inspire our diverse community with art and history exhibitions, collections, and public programs that are inclusive, educational, and relevant; and,
