Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Terminating Proclamations Of A Local Emergency Due to De-Energization

Whereas, on October 21, 2019, the Director of Emergency Services for the County of Sonoma issued a Proclamation of a Local Emergency for the County of Sonoma, State of California, related to the imminent and likely de-energization of a substantial portion of the County of Sonoma; and

Whereas, pursuant to Sonoma County Code Chapter 10, Article 1, Section 10-5, where the Director of Emergency Services proclaims a local emergency, the Board of Supervisors must ratify said proclamation within seven days after such proclamation; and

Whereas, on October 22, 2019, the Board of Supervisors ratified the Proclamation of a Local Emergency by the County of Sonoma's Director of Emergency Services and found that the circumstances of the de-energization as described in the Director's Proclamation of Local Emergency did support and justify the declaration of local emergency as set forth therein; and

Whereas, the circumstances of the de-energization as described in the Director's Proclamation of a Local Emergency no longer exist;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved the Board of Supervisors does hereby terminate the Proclamation of Local Emergency, effective immediately upon the adoption of this resolution.
