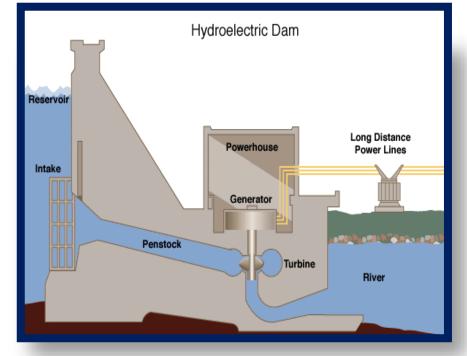

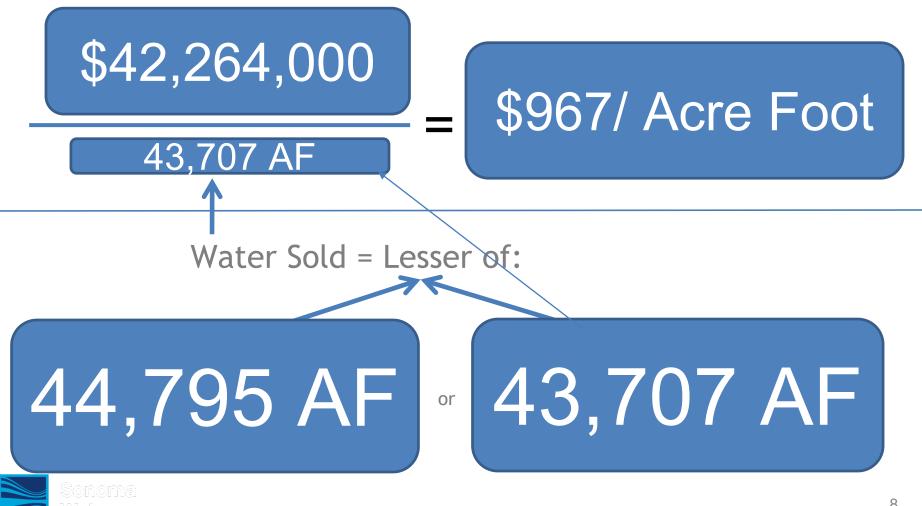

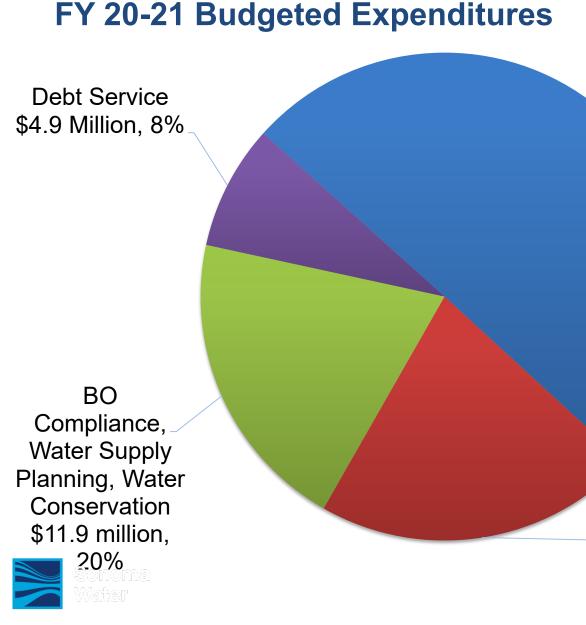

Biological Opinion Compliance, Water Supply Planning, Water Conservation 19¢

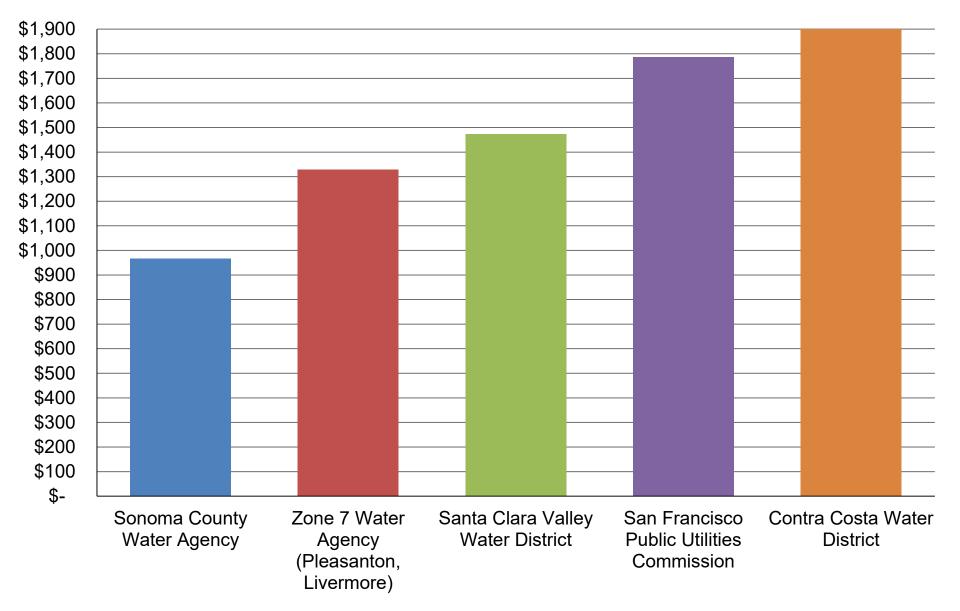
Example Rate Increase for Family of Four
