OPTIONS: CAP AT JUNE 23 LEVEL, OR CAP AT TODAY'S LEVEL


- JUNE 23 = 1,904 PERMITS (3 COMPLETE & APPROVED SINCE)
- TODAY* = 1,907 ISSUED + 25 APPLIED SINCE JUNE 23 AND COMPLETE: 1,932 TOTAL

- URGENCY ORDINANCE
- REQUIRES 4/5 VOTE
- IN EFFECT FOR 45 DAYS
- WILL REQUEST EXTENSION (UP TO 2 YEARS)
 - DATA COLLECTION, PUBLIC OUTREACH, ANALYSIS & RECOMMENDATIONS
 - TARGET RETURN DATE JANUARY 2021
