Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State Of California,
Authorizing A Budgetary Adjustment To The 2020-2021 Budget Establishing Appropriations
for the use of Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) state allocated
funds.

Whereas, on June 20, 2020 the Board of Supervisors approved the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Recommended Budget for the County of Sonoma; and

Whereas, July 27 and 28, 2020, the Board of Supervisors conducted the FY 2020-21 Budget workshop presentation; and

Whereas, the County Administrator recommended uses of the state \$50.6 million CARES funding allocation and

Whereas, the County Administrator recommended that part of the allocation be programmed for indirect county operational costs resulting from the pandemic impacts; and

Whereas, the Government Code allows for adjustments to the Budget during the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year if approved by the Board with a 4/5ths vote; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the County Auditor-Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to make all necessary operating transfers, accounting entries, and the following budgetary adjustments:
