WHEREAS, he served in the 194th Glider Infantry Regiment, 17th Airborne Division Company "E", and

WHEREAS, he earned the Victory in Europe pin, a Bronze Star for heroism, the Combat Infantry Badge and a Purple Heart, and

WHEREAS, Leonard R. Mittelstadt fought in the Battle of the Bulge and Operation Varsity where he was wounded, and

WHEREAS, after the war, Leonard and his brother Francis, with whom he had joined and Army and served alongside, both moved to Cloverdale, where they bought Barnes Lumber Company from their parents, and

WHEREAS, he could often be found at Cloverdale Eagles football games, served as president of the Cloverdale Lions Club and enjoyed fishing for steelhead in the Russian River, and

WHEREAS, Leonard R. Mittelstadt died on May 14, 2020, after a long and distinguished life, and
