Honoring and Acknowledging Petaluma City Councilmember Kathy Miller

for Eight Years of Exemplary Public Service to the People of Petaluma

Whereas, Kathy Miller was elected to the Petaluma City Council in 2012, and re-elected in 2016 serving the people of Petaluma with distinction for eight years until 2020; and

Whereas, during her dedicated service on the Council, Councilmember Miller listed among her priorities parks, transportation and pedestrian safety; and

Whereas, Councilmember Miller, the sole eastside council member, was instrumental in achieving the Petaluma Community Sports Fields, which provides a place to play for many local youth leagues in East Petaluma; and

Whereas, appointed to the Sonoma County Transportation Authority/Regional Climate Protection Authority in 2015, Councilmember Miller advocated for funding to widen Highway 101 through Petaluma, including the addition of sound walls and appropriation of space for the future Rainier crosstown connector; and

Whereas, Councilmember Miller's assistance in securing the City's first new revenue source, Measure U, ensures a lasting legacy of community benefit.
