#### **Redistricting Law**


- Division 21—California Elections Code
- Fair Maps Act (AB 849)
  - Revises and standardizes redistricting
  - Eliminates discretionary criteria and rules
  - Mandatory requirements with "priorities"





#### Fair Maps Act

- District boundaries may not be adopted for the purpose of favoring or discriminating against a political party
- Limits alteration between census
- Establishes <u>specific timeline for</u> <u>adoption of a plan</u>





#### Fair Maps Act (cont'd)

- Mandates more rigorous public outreach and public hearing requirements
  - Minority communities
  - Language access
  - Dissemination
    - Website requirement
    - Translation requirements
    - 10-year maintenance





#### Who Draws?



- Historically
- Fair Maps Act allows Board to appoint Advisory or Independent Commission
  - Composition may vary
  - Certain restrictions
  - Permissive, not mandatory
  - Roles:
    - Advisory—makes recommendations to Board
    - Independent—empowered to create boundaries



#### **Advisory Redistricting Commission**

- Board prescribes how members are appointed to the advisory redistricting commission, but prohibits
  - Persons who are Sonoma County elected officials
  - Family members, staff members, or paid campaign staff of elected Sonoma County officials





#### Timeframe

- Not later than 174 days before next regulation election after January 1, 2022, but before July 1, 2022
- December 15, 2021 is 174 days before June 7, 2022 statewide primary





#### **Public Hearings**

- At least 4 public hearings required
  - One before draft map drawn
  - At least two after map drawn
  - At least one on a Saturday, Sunday, or after 6:00 pm Monday—Friday





#### **Public Outreach**



- County <u>must encourage</u> public participation by:
  - Publishing draft map 7 days prior to adoption
  - Media outreach
  - Outreach to community groups
  - Live translation at meeting
  - Posting notices on internet
  - Publication of relevant demographics data
  - Take public testimony through various medium



#### Recordkeeping

- Must make record of every public comment and governing body available within 2 weeks
- Webpage must be maintained for 10 years in multiple languages AND must contain:
  - Explanation of process
  - Procedure for providing oral or written testimony
  - Calendar of hearings and workshops
  - Notice and agenda for hearings and workshops
  - Recording or written summary of each hearing/workshop
  - All draft maps
  - Final adopted map





#### **Mid-Decade Changes**



# Prohibited unless in conjunction with:

- Judicial proceedings
- Jurisdictional boundary change




#### The Parameters

- Population equality
- Compliance with Federal law
- Districts must be contiguous
- Must respect geographic integrity of neighborhoods
- Must respect geographic integrity of incorporated cities
- District boundaries must be easily identifiable and understandable to residents
- Must respect geographic compactness (to extent possible)

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#### **Advisory Redistricting Commission**

- Composition
  - District Appointees
  - At-Large Position
- Criteria
- Application Period February 24, 2021 through March 16, 2021

#### **Recommended Actions**

- 1. Receive update on redistricting process for 2021;
- 2. Adopt resolution establishing the Sonoma County Advisory Redistricting Commission (ARC) and adopting rules and procedures;
- 3. Direct staff to solicit interest in serving on the ARC and return to the Board on March 16, 2021, with applications and recommendations for appointment of members to the ARC;
- 4. Authorize the use of \$130,000 from contingency funds for contracts to procure specialized redistricting facilitation and training services, interactive mapping technology, and unanticipated translation and interpretation services to support the redistricting process.
