FIRST AMENDMENT TO PERMIT SONOMA GRANT AGREEMENT

This First Amendment ("Amendment"), dated as of March 2nd, 2021, is by and between the County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County"), and Career Technical Education Foundation, hereinafter referred to as ("Grantee").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Grantee entered into that certain Agreement, dated May 1, 2018, for Work-Based Learning Program; and

WHEREAS, County and Grantee desire to amend the Agreement to alter the scope of work due to interruptions caused by the global health pandemic related to COVID-19; and

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

- 1. Agreement Section 3. Term of Agreement is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - 3. Term of Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall be from May 1, 2018 to December 31st 2022
- 2. <u>Exhibit A: Scope of Work</u>, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Exhibit A: Scope of Work.
- 3. Except to the extent the Agreement is specifically amended or supplemented hereby, the Agreement, together with exhibits is, and shall continue to be, in full force and effect as originally executed, and nothing contained herein shall, or shall be construed to modify, invalidate or otherwise affect any provision of the Agreement or any right of County arising thereunder.
- 5. This Amendment shall be governed by and construed under the internal laws of the state of California, and any action to enforce the terms of this Amendment or for the breach thereof shall be brought and tried in the County of Sonoma.

Exhibit A: Scope of Work

1. Launch two new sustainable agriculture courses beginning August 2021.

- A. Economic, Environmental & Social Principles of Sustainable Agriculture: This interdisciplinary agriculture course utilizes a hands-on approach to teach students about the history of agriculture, its impact on human civilization, the move to industrialized farming and commensurate environmental impacts, and tools and techniques available to farmers today that ensure healthy and sustainable foods systems now and in the future. Students will study the impacts of climate change on local farming operations and will become familiar with precision-agriculture technologies that assist with data analysis, soil, water and pest management, as well as renewable energy and labor-saving mechanisms. This course provides "G" Elective credit for UC/CSU eligibility. It also aligns with State CTE Agriculture Pathway standards and will provide commensurate CTE credit.
- B. Air, Water and Elements: This interdisciplinary science course will teach students how to create vertical organic farms leveraging aeroponics technology. Students will learn about soil science, water usage, cell biology, chemistry, plant physiology and impacts of a variety of environmental factors that affect agriculture. Students will apply their knowledge in the development of business and marketing plans to sell their agricultural output to the school cafeteria or at farmers markets. This course has been approved to provide "D" Lab Science credit for UC/CSU eligibility. The course also aligns with State CTE Agriculture Pathway standards and will provide commensurate CTE credit when taught by a credentialed CTE Ag instructor.

2. Purchase instructional supplies and equipment by September 2021.

A. Purchase textbooks, relevant equipment, instructional materials and supplies required to implement two new courses.

3. Develop and secure partnerships with local employers to create relevant work-based learning (WBL) experiences by December 2021.

- A. Identify up to two industry partners to participate in delivering instruction and providing WBL experiences for students.
- B. Partner with educators to develop industry-led projects aligned with curriculum and desired learning outcomes.
