Point Blue Conservation Science and Revocable License Agreement for Terms of 20 Years

Whereas, Point Blue Conservation Science (Point Blue) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that has worked to restore native habitats for the last 30 years by establishing tens of thousands of native plants and removing invasive species to improve water quality, biodiversity and mitigate climate change; and

Whereas, in 2017 Point Blue was awarded a grant from the California State Coastal Conservancy (Conservancy) to conduct restoration activities in Crane Creek Regional Park and Taylor Mountain Regional Park and Open Space Preserve; and

Whereas, the Conservancy requires site access for both grantor (Conservancy) and grantee (Point Blue) for a term of 20 years; and

Whereas, Sonoma County Regional Parks owns and operates Crane Creek Regional Park and Taylor Mountain Regional Park and Open Space Preserve; and

Whereas, the Director of Regional Parks requests authorization to execute the Landowner Access Agreements and Revocable License Agreements for both Crane Creek Regional Park and Taylor Mountain Regional Park with Point Blue;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Regional Parks to execute the Landowner Agreements, execute Revocable License Agreements, and facilitate riparian restoration on parklands.
