2020 Disaster Response RFP

For what purpose(s) do you anticipate using the requested funds?

The itemized list below, to the total of \$75,000, will drastically improve our capacity to respond to future disasters and to recoup costs from previous disasters. To prepare for the future, we will need ongoing training to ensure our staff are following best practices for their safety and the safety of the animals. We will need to properly outfit our field staff with protective gear to respond to disaster events. All training listed below are useful for response activities and are in relation to the types of disasters/emergencies we respond to yearly and an ongoing basis. Some classes require annual recertification.

In 2019, the SCAS animal shelter lost power for several days due to Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS). We needed to procure a generator as back up to ensure continuity of service and to power the shelter in these instances. Many more PSPS events are expected in the future. We received a grant in the amount of \$22,000 but due to the size of our facility, this did not cover costs. The generator recommended for our facility was \$90,000. We have utilized operational funds to cover the balance of this equipment and are requesting \$34,559 to offset the departmental cost of this purchase. The generator is essential to capacity building as it allow us to remain immediately in operation for any disaster that comes along. Previously, our capacity was hampered by having to request and install generators to power the facility. Having the generator allow us to continue to provide robust support and care for animals and their guardians in Sonoma County, California.
