### **Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, Proclaiming April 5 to April 11, 2021 as National Public Health Week in Sonoma County**

**Whereas**, the County of Sonoma recognizes that the county, state, nation has experienced COVID-19 pandemic as the most profound public health challenge of the century;

**Whereas**, the national theme for Public Health Week for 2021 is “Building Bridges to Better Health;

**Whereas**, Sonoma County mourns for our families and friends whose lives have been altered forever by over more than 290 deaths and 27,500 cases of COVID-19;

**Whereas**, Sonoma County acknowledges the clear disproportionate impact of COVID-19 in the Latinx, indigenous, and other communities of color locally; and

**Whereas**, Sonoma County celebrates the multiple community-based organizations within Sonoma County including volunteers, State Colleagues, CDC Foundation, Public Health Institute, IsoCare, COVID-19 Urgent Response and Aid (CURA), and Community Organizations Active in Disaster (COAD) who have helped manage the COVID-19 challenges and especially the diverse populations disproportionately affected.
