Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Authorizing the District Attorney to Sign an Agreement with the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance for Federal Fiscal Years 2020/2021 and 2021/2022, in the amount of \$340,000.

Whereas, the Sonoma County District Attorney desires to implement a certain project designated as Sonoma County Opioid Prosecution Effort, funded by the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance Innovative Prosecution Solutions Program; and

Whereas, the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance has allocated \$340,000 to the Sonoma County District Attorney for the term October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2022.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that District Attorney Jill Ravitch, is authorized, on behalf of this body, to execute the Innovative Prosecution Solutions Grant Award Agreement, including any modifications or extensions thereof, with the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, and to accept \$340,000 in grant funding for the term October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2022.
