Whereas, on December 13, 2016 the Board of Supervisors approved the Sonoma-Mendocino Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS), and endorsed an application to the United States Economic Development Administration to form an Economic Development District with Mendocino County; and

Whereas, The Economic Development Board has received grant funding from the United States Economic Development Administration to undertake the development of an updated CEDS, including a regional focus on recovery and resiliency; and

Whereas, with the staffing support of the Strategic and Resilient Initiative Analyst (CST: Department Analyst), the Economic Development Board will have sufficient capacity to fully address the development and execution of CEDS-related initiatives, as well as those of the Sonoma County Coronavirus Recovery Action Plan, and Strategic Sonoma; and

Whereas, Human Resources agrees that the Strategic and Resilient Initiative Analyst is the appropriate position for the duties and responsibilities required to support the Economic Development Board's vision of a healthy and vibrant economy for all in Sonoma County; and

Whereas, The Economic Development Board has obtained partial funding through a United States Economic Development Administration grant for this position;
