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## Sonoma County's Daily Metrics (06/07)

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Unadjusted Case Rate: 3.5 Adjusted Case Rate: 2.7
Testing Positivity (Overall): 1.3\%
Testing Positivity (Lowest HPI Quartile): 1.4\%
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- Sonoma County's adjusted case rate of new cases per 100,000 residents per day has shown a slight decrease over the past two weeks


## Testing and Positivity

Tests per 100,000 per day, excl prisoners (7 day avg w/ 7 day lag) for Sonoma

- Testing volume of 349.7 tests per 100,000 people per day
- State testing median=255.2
- Test positivity is trending upward, especially for individuals aged 25-34 years


## Source of Infection

Proportion of Cases Attributable to Specific Exposure Locations


- Unvaccinated individuals account for the large majority of cases
- Approximately $75 \%$ of cases are $<45$ years of age
- Household transmission, gatherings, and travel remain the primary contributors of transmission

72\% of the Sonoma County population aged $12+$ is at least partially vaccinated

## Proportion of Each Age Group Vaccinated

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- Over $91 \%$ of adults $70+$ and $75+$ are at least partially vaccinated
- All age groups $45+$ years have test positivity of $<1 \%$, positivity for age groups under 45 has increased slightly with test positivity $>1 \%, 18-34$ yr olds $>2 \%$


## Proportion Vaccinated Within Each Race/Ethnicity



- Though an underestimate, as race/ethnicity info is not reported for all vaccinated individuals, this chart suggests that at least 56\% Latino/Hispanic, 69\% White, 71\% Asian, 70\% Black, 29\% Multiracial, 86\% American Indian/Alaskan Native, and 72\% Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders who are $12+$ have been partially or fully vaccinated


## Vaccine Equity Measures




- Currently, $24 \%$ of vaccine doses have been administered to residents in the lowest quartile of the Healthy Places Index in which residents have access to the fewest resources
- $59 \%$ of residents in this quartile are at least partially vaccinated (11\% partially vaccinated; 48\% fully vaccinated)
