Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California,

Honoring Lucas Berry for Achieving the Rank of Eagle Scout

Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America have a long and impressive history of preparing young men to assume responsibility in their communities; and

Whereas, Lucas Berry is a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 74 of Petaluma, and has worked diligently and completed his ranking of Eagle Scout; and

**Whereas,** Lucas earned 21 merit badges, and served in several leadership positions including Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader and Quartermaster; and

Whereas, Lucas has attended four summer camps, Camp Marin Sierra, Camp Fleischmann, Camp Chawanakee and Camp Wente, and his favorite outings were the 50 miler hikes with one full week of hiking and camping in Lassen National Forest (three times), Tahoe National Forest, Adams Wilderness and the Hoover Wilderness; and

Whereas, Lucas's Eagle Scout Project consisted of constructing 110 feet of split rail fencing in Helen Putnam Regional Park, which required planning the project to meet Sonoma County Regional Park specifications, coordinating and scheduling work crews while adhering to COVID safety best practices including providing masks and hand sanitizer, using an auger to drill holes for the fence posts which were set in native soil, and connected with two horizontal rails. This Eagle Project discourages park users from walking or cycling off-trail on a steep downhill

slope, enhancing trail safety, preventing soil erosion, and encouraging growth of newly planted								
native trees.
