Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California,

A majority of the Board of Commissioners of the Sonoma County Community Development Commission, a California body corporate and politic ("Recipient"), hereby consent to, adopt and ratify the following resolutions:

Resolution Authorizing the Commission to Enter Into Standard Agreements with the California Department of Housing and Community Development regarding an Award from The Project Homekey Program

Whereas, the Recipient is authorized to do business in the State of California; and

Whereas, the Recipient has been approved to receive an allocation of funds through the Project Homekey Grant Program from the California Department of Housing and Community Development ("Department");

Now, Therefore, It Is Resolved: That the Recipient has agreed to accept an allocation of funds in the amount of \$8,800,000 for the Hotel Azura and \$6,200,000 for the Sebastopol Inn under Project Homekey.

Resolved Further: That in connection with the Project Homekey Grants, the Recipient is authorized and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to carry into effect the full intent and purpose of the above resolution, in order to evidence the Project Homekey Grants, the Recipient's obligations related thereto, and the Department's security therefore; including, but not limited to, an affordable housing covenant, a relocation agreement, and certain other documents required by the Department as security for, evidence of or pertaining to the Project Homekey Grants, and all amendments thereto (collectively, the "Project Homekey Grant Documents").

Resolved Further: That the Interim Executive Director, Dave Kiff, or their designee is hereby authorized to execute the Project Homekey Grant Documents, and any amendment or modifications thereto, on behalf of the Commission.

Resolved Further: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
