Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, authorizing the District Attorney to participate in the Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims Program and to execute a contract with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for Calendar Year 2021 in the amount of \$197,372.

Whereas, the Sonoma County District Attorney desires to continue a certain program designated as the Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims program, a system of enhanced survivor-driven advocacy, counseling, housing assistance and referral services for the foster care youth ages 5 to 22 in Sonoma County; and

Whereas, the continuation of the Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims program is to be funded in part from funds made available through a federal Victims of Crime Act Victim Assistance Formula Grant Program made available through California Governor's Office of Emergency Services; and

Whereas, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has allocated \$197,372 to the County of Sonoma for the 2021 Calendar Year.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the District Attorney of the County of Sonoma is authorized, on behalf of this body, to accept a grant for the Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims Program from California Governor's Office of Emergency Services and is authorized to execute on behalf of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors the Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or modifications thereof.
