

## **BROADBAND FOR RURAL CALIFORNIA**

## Objective: Increase access to reliable, affordable high-speed broadband for all rural Californians

RCRC is preparing the formation of a joint powers authority entitled Golden State Connect Authority to implement RCRC's objective through advancing the establishment of broadband infrastructure in rural counties. This will occur in three phases: 51.3% of rural Californians do not have access to high speed internet
