Summary and Purpose of Ad Hoc

The Emergency Medical Service Ad-Hoc Committee was formed to inform the Board on the following three issues: 1) the status and proposed revisions to the Sonoma EMS Ordinance; 2) the status and proposed process for the competitive procurement of ambulance services within an exclusive operating area; and 3) the provision of emergency medical services in non-competitive operating areas outside the designated exclusive operating area. The intended outcome is to inform the board regarding the above EMS projects and stakeholder engagement process; to receive direction from the Board on the above issues and related policy matters; with the overarching goal of improving the effectiveness and quality of ambulance services in Sonoma County.
