Executive Summary:

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (TPW) is requesting adoption of a Gold Resolution recognizing the week of May 15-21, 2022 as National Public Works Week. The Department is comprised of the following divisions: Roads (Design and Maintenance), Airport, Transit, and Integrated Waste Management, and is committed to providing excellent transportation and public works services in a responsive, equitable, and professional manner to benefit residents and visitors of Sonoma County. The professionals staffing the County's Transportation and Public Works Department help to ensure that Sonoma County's infrastructure and public services remain accessible, reliable, and resilient. The requested action formally recognizes the contributions made by these individuals.

National Public Works Week was instituted as a public education campaign by the American Public Works Association in 1960, calling attention to the importance of public works in community life.
